The four hundred and sixty-seventh meeting of the Personnel Commission of the Ventura County Community College District was held on Thursday, June 19, 2014 at 5:30 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Gonzales called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

On motion by Commissioner King and seconded by Commissioner Harison, the minutes of the Thursday, May 15, 2014 meeting of the Personnel Commission were approved.

Director Arnoldus stated that the Personnel Commission budget for fiscal year 2015 was approved by the Ventura County Office of Education with two minor changes that were made due to rounding errors.

Director Arnoldus indicated that he was not in attendance and noted the new Chief of Police was sworn in at the meeting.

Director Arnoldus reviewed the *Current Recruitments Report* that included six current classified recruitments. The *Positions Filled Report* reflected eleven positions filled and five positions pending. The *Upcoming Recruitments Report* included three upcoming recruitments.

8. DISCUSSION OF PERSONNEL COMMISSION RULE 295

The Commission allowed Ms. Olivia Long, Curriculum Technician at Ventura College, to address the Commission. Ms. Long requested an amendment of the Personnel Commission Rule 295 with a retroactive date of May 16, 2013, and the basis for the proposed amendment request.

Director Arnoldus presented a conceptual framework for a revision of Rule 295 based on proposed changes to Rule 292.

Discussion ensued between the Commissioners and Director Arnoldus, after which the Commissioners requested that Director Arnoldus draft language for review at the July 17, 2014 Personnel Commission meeting. No action was taken.
