The U.S. Department of Education (DOE) recently established new regulations which reduce the duration of a student's eligibility to receive a federal Pell Grant to a maximum of 12 full-time semesters (or its equivalent). Beginning with Fall 2012, a student has <u>6 years</u> (12 full-time semesters) of total Pell Grant lifetime eligibility. This applies to all students and includes *all* years Pell was received prior to Fall 2012 at all schools. (Pell payments are added together for all colleges attended anywhere.) Because you are close to reaching or have exceeded these new lifetime Pell Grant limits, please **complete the following steps and attach all required documentation:**

Step 1: Attach your academic plan <u>developed by your counselor</u>. If you submitted an academic plan to the Financial Aid Office for the 2011-12 (or 2012-13) school year, no additional plan is required.

Step 2: Enter your lifetime Pell Grant Lifetime Eligibility Used (LEU) _______. (In **mid-July 2012**, you will be able to log on to the <u>National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) Student Access Web site</u> using your <u>Federal Student Aid PIN</u> and view your LEU. The LEU will be found on the Financial Aid Review page. If you are unable to access this information, the Financial Aid Specialist will assist you with retrieving this information at your scheduled appointment.)

Step 3: Schedule an appointment with a Financial Aid Specialist to review available educational funding options. (Please make sure you bring this form and your completed academic plan to your appointment with the Financial Aid Specialist.)
