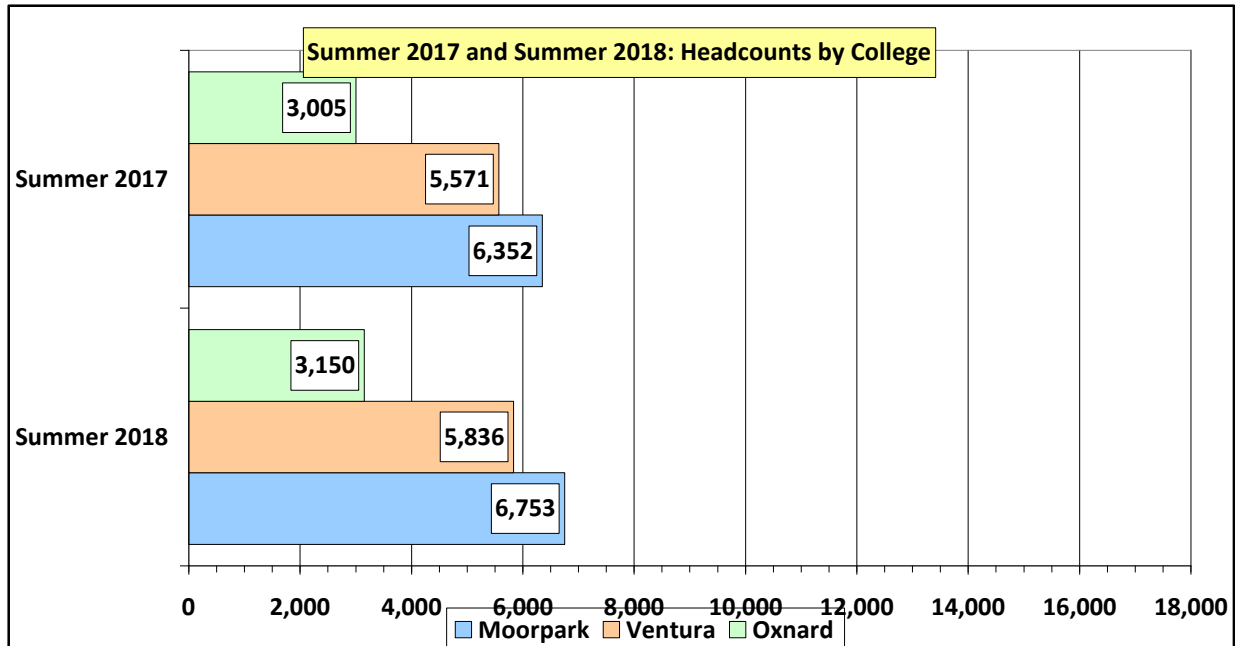

■ Summer 2018 – SELECTED STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

• First-Time Students Who are Recent Graduates of Local High Schools

The table displays the numbers of **first-time VCCCD** students who are **recent graduates (2017 or 2018)** of **local high schools** (except for Agoura High, all schools are located in Ventura County). The schools are **ranked** based on the **total district-wide number of units** taken by **first-time** students from those high schools. A complete listing of the high schools appears on **pages 14 – 16** of this report.

The **top** school **Westlake High** with 32 recent graduates who are enrolled in **127.0 units** at VCCCD colleges. The **second-ranked** school is **Oak Park High**, with **22** recent graduates at VCCCD colleges who are enrolled in **123 units**. **Camarillo High** is **third** with **31** students enrolled in **121.0 units**.

1,396.5 total units ÷ 398 unduplicated first-time students from local HSs = 3.5 units per student.

• **Student Ethnic Background**

The table displays the numbers of **VCCCD credit-unit** enrollments as they relate to students' ethnic backgrounds. For each group, the **Prcnts** show how the credit-units from that group are distributed at each college or district-wide.
