RESOLUTION NO. 2019-07 SUPPORT FOR AND DECLARATION OF CLEAN AIR DAY

Whereas, at every opportunity the Ventura County Community College District seeks to expand upon our existing sustainability efforts, programs, and plans; and


Whereas, the Ventura County Community College District has partnered with Ventura County Transportation Commission to provide free bus transportation through the College Ride Program; and

Be it further resolved that we encourage all students, employees, and community members to participate in Clean Air Day and help clear the air for all Californians.




