SSSP Task Force Update	Richard Duran provided the SSSP Taskforce update. He indicated the SSSP Taskforce met on Friday, September 5 and reviewed the taskforce charge, membership and current work progress. The taskforce is currently reviewing the equity plan and determination of the distribution of equity funds. Equity plans are due to the State on January 1, 2015.
