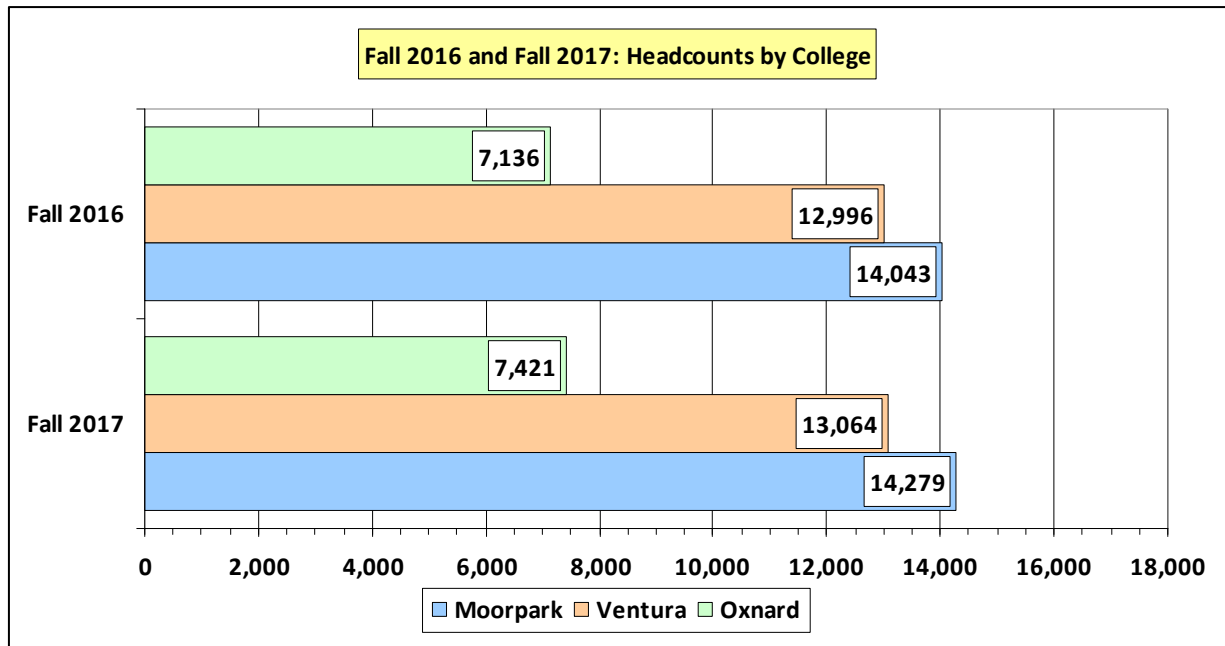

**■ FALL 2017 – SELECTED STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS**

● **First-Time Students Who are Recent Graduates of Local High Schools**

The table displays the numbers of **first-time VCCCD** students who are **recent graduates (2016 or 2017)** of **local high schools** (except for Agoura High, all schools are located in Ventura County). The schools are **ranked** based on the **total district-wide number of units** taken by **first-time** students from those high schools.

The **top** school is **Pacifica High** with **287** recent graduates who are enrolled in **3,502.5 units** at VCCCD colleges. The **second-ranked** school is **Oxnard High**, with **268** recent graduates at VCCCD colleges who are enrolled in **3,173 units**. **Camarillo High** is **third** with **230** students enrolled in **2,829.0 units**.

**Note:** Some students attend more than one VCCCD college; therefore, the district total is less than the **sum** of college enrollments. Calculation of **overall average units** is:  
**42,253.5** total units ÷ **3,453** unduplicated first-time students from local HSs = **8.2** units per student.

• **Student Ethnic Background**
