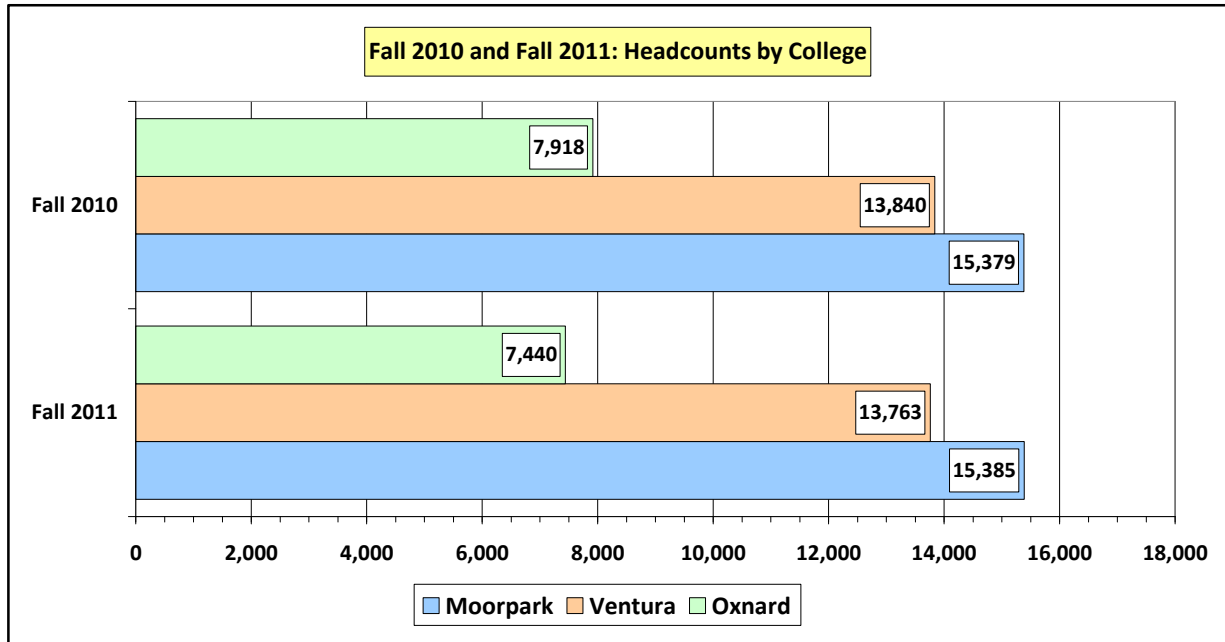

■ **FALL 2011 – SELECTED STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS**

● **First-Time Students Who are Recent Graduates of Local High Schools**

The table displays the numbers of **first-time VCCCD** students who are **recent graduates (2011 or 2012)** of **local high schools** (except for Agoura High, all schools are located in Ventura County). The schools are **ranked** based on the **total district-wide number of units** taken by **first-time** students from those high schools. A complete listing of the high schools appears on **pages 14 – 16** of this report.

The **top** school is **Oxnard High** with **342** recent graduates who are enrolled in **3,845.5 units** at VCCCD colleges. The **second-ranked** school is **Pacifica High**, with **332** recent graduates at VCCCD colleges who are enrolled in **4,001.5 units**. **Royal High** is **third** with **281** students enrolled in **3,410.5 units**.

**Note:** Some students attend more than one VCCCD college; therefore, the district total is less than the **sum** of college enrollments. Calculation of **overall average units** is:  
**54,512** total units ÷ **4,636** unduplicated first-time students from local HSs = **8.5** units per student.

• **Student Ethnic Background**

The table displays the numbers of **VCCCD credit-unit** enrollments as they relate to students' ethnic backgrounds.
