(March 18, 2021)— The Ventura County Community College District (VCCCD) board of trustees has selected Matt Escobedo, assistant human resources director at the County of Ventura, to become a member of the Personnel Commission. Escobedo will serve a three-year term on the three-member commission, which is charged with ensuring fair and objective treatment of classified applicants and employees in all aspects of personnel administration.

Escobedo has over 15 years of progressively responsible public-sector human resources management experience, which includes working for the Los Angeles Unified School District, VCCCD, City of Santa Monica and County of Ventura.

Escobedo, who cites collaboration and relationship building as his strengths, oversees County of Ventura staff engaged in various activities, including recruitment, classification and compensation, and equal employment opportunity. He has served as a member of the County Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Task Force since 2017. He is also a member of the Ventura County Leadership Academy, cohort XXVI.

“Matt’s deep commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion impressed the board, and we look forward to engaging in a variety of objectives to further promote these important initiatives within the District,” said Trustee Gabriela Torres.
