Accessibility & Digital Content Compliance

Accessibility is everyone's responsibility! Effective April 24, 2026, new ADA Title II regulations issued by the U.S. Department of Justice require state and local governments—including public colleges—to ensure that web content and mobile applications meet WCAG 2.1 Level AA accessibility standards. These requirements apply to digital materials such as websites, online forms, PDFs, email communications, and instructional content, ensuring access for individuals with disabilities.

To support employees in meeting these requirements, the following accessibility-focused training opportunities are available:

Banner Finance Training

A prerequisite for Requisition Training, this session orients new users and refreshes existing ones on Banner Finance. Participants must verify their Banner responsibilities and FOAP access beforehand.

Banner Requisition Training

For Banner Finance users who have already completed introductory Banner Finance Training, have Banner Finance access, and need to learn how to enter requisitions into Banner.

Deans and Directors Institute

This institute provides Deans and Directors an opportunity to collaborate across the colleges on key functions of their roles. Each session focuses on a new topic, with space for shared learning and discussion. Connect with colleagues across campuses to strengthen collaboration, communication, and effective practice.

EEO at VCCCD: Decolonized: The Matriarchs

Ventura College and Stagebound, Inc. present an immersive, multi-artist journey into the heart of American music and history. Celebrate the legacy of Black and Native American women—the original architects of our cultural landscape. Through a powerful blend of live performance, archival visuals, and historical storytelling, this "performance-lecture" examines how Indigenous and Black artistry has been influenced, misappropriated, and ultimately reclaimed. This cultural masterclass is designed to challenge, inspire, and honor the matriarchs who paved the way.

EEO at VCCCD: Equity-Mindedness and Faculty Hiring Workshop

Designed for faculty hiring committee members, this workshop with Dr. Román Liera explores equity in hiring, addressing bias, and creating fair, inclusive hiring criteria.

EEO at VCCCD: Title V Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) Training for Selection Committees

Required for all employees serving on classified interview panels or academic hiring committees. Review legal and regulatory framework, equity in hiring, address bias, creating fair, inclusive hiring criteria, avoiding discriminatory practices, and promoting a diverse workforce.

Introduction to Mindfulness for Stress Relief

Discover mindfulness and meditation techniques to manage stress, improve focus, and support better sleep in this engaging workshop.

Introduction to Performance Management and the Classified Evaluation Process

Supervisors and Department Chairs will receive an overview of laws and court decisions of employee rights to privacy and management's right to information. Emphasis is placed on a continuously developing area of law - privacy issues in the computerized workplace.

LCW Workshop Series: Privacy, Technology and Online Activities: Where's the Line?

Supervisors will review key issues related to online instruction, including privacy, participatory governance, negotiable items, public records requirements, use of chats/breakout rooms, camera and recording expectations, FERPA compliance, and student discipline issues in virtual settings.

LCW Workshop Series: Temporary Faculty Members

Supervisors and Department Chairs will review important employment actions, such as the “67 % rule,” when & how faculty can acquire tenure, and the differences between persons employed before 1967 and after 1967.

LCW Workshop Series: Office Hours

A town hall-style session where supervisors and HR staff can ask employment, labor, and education law questions directly to legal experts.

LCW Workshop Series: Retirement Issues for California’s Community College and K-12 Districts

HR staff will review retirement issues in public education, with emphasis on benefits under CalPERS and CalSTRS, and topics related to membership, pensionable compensation, service credit, post-retirement employment, and the impact of the Public Employees’ Pension Reform Act of 2013.

LCW Workshop Series: Evaluation, Discipline and Non Re-Employment of Contract Faculty

Supervisors will explore correct procedures for evaluation of new faculty and discuss available options if new faculty does not meet expectations of the college administration and/or fellow faculty.

Leadership & Management Basics

Explore core differences between leadership and management, engagement strategies in higher ed, and how to enhance communication and coaching skills through this highly interactive session.

Real Colors® Fundamentals Workshop

Discover your personality strengths using the Real Colors framework and learn to communicate more effectively, foster inclusion, and strengthen appreciation of the diverse traits of colleagues.

Retirement Benefits Basics

Hosted by CalPERS, this class provides a general overview of your CalPERS benefits and the choices you have to maximize your retirement security.

Retirement Planning: A Guide for Early- and Mid-Career Employees

Hosted by CalPERS, this session reviews how your retirement benefit is calculated, the options you have to set aside money for retirement in addition to your pension, what happens if you pass away or leave your employer before you retire, power of attorney, what you can find and do in your myCalPERS account and more.
